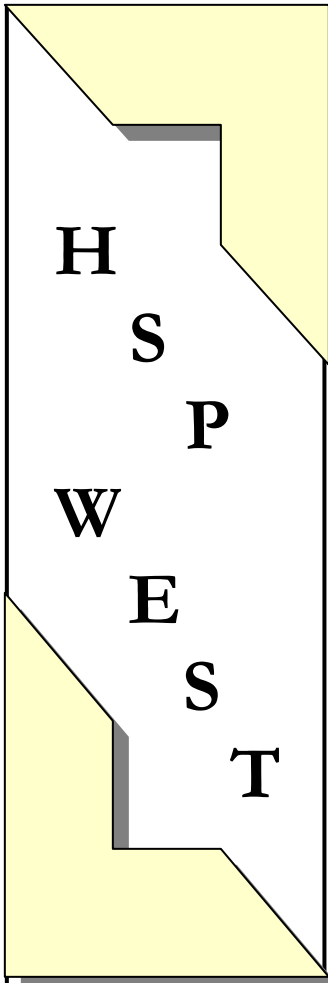

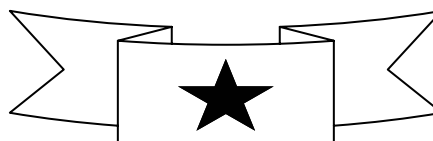
I am very excited to be your new President of HSP West and look forward to a fun year of networking, learning, educating and bringing you, the members, experiences that strengthen your HSP West involvement.
